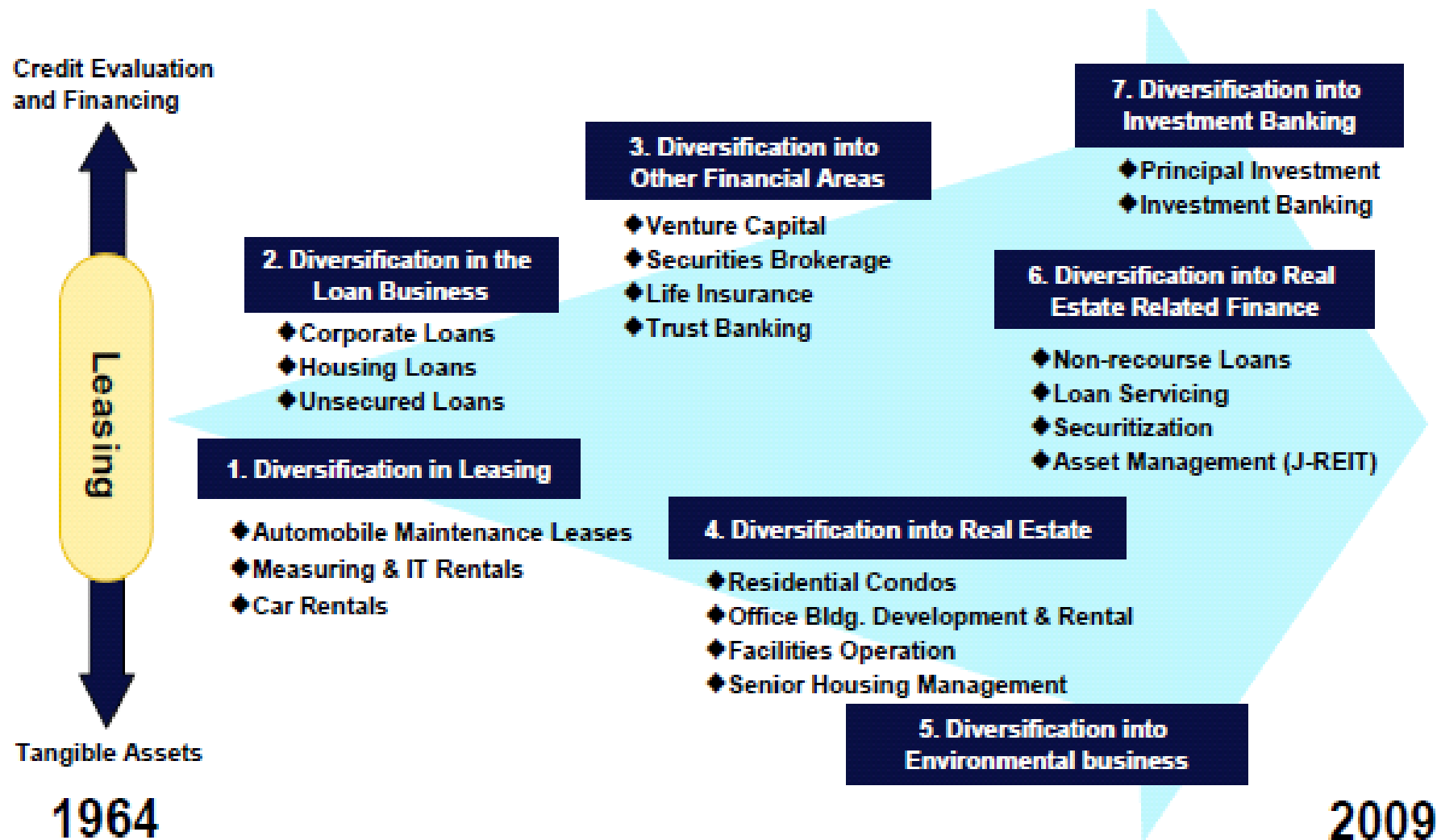

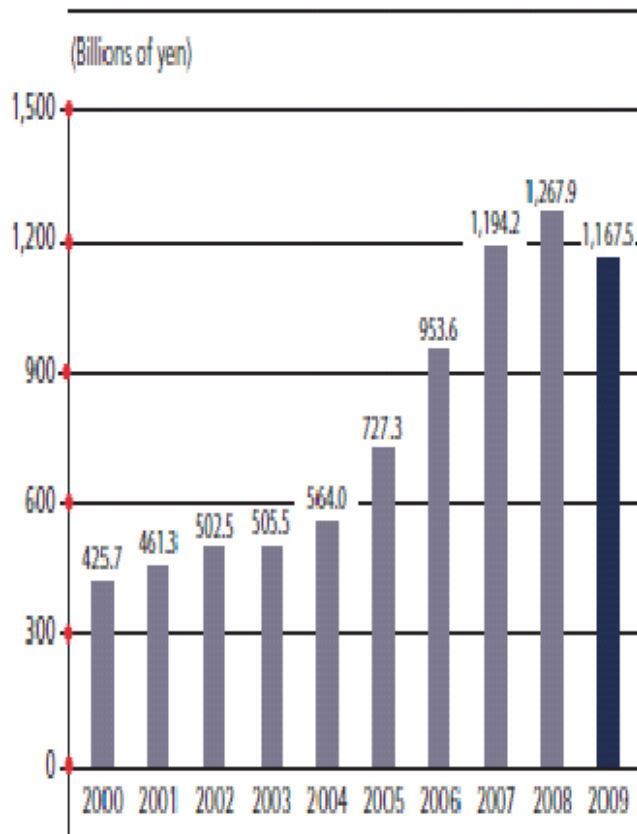

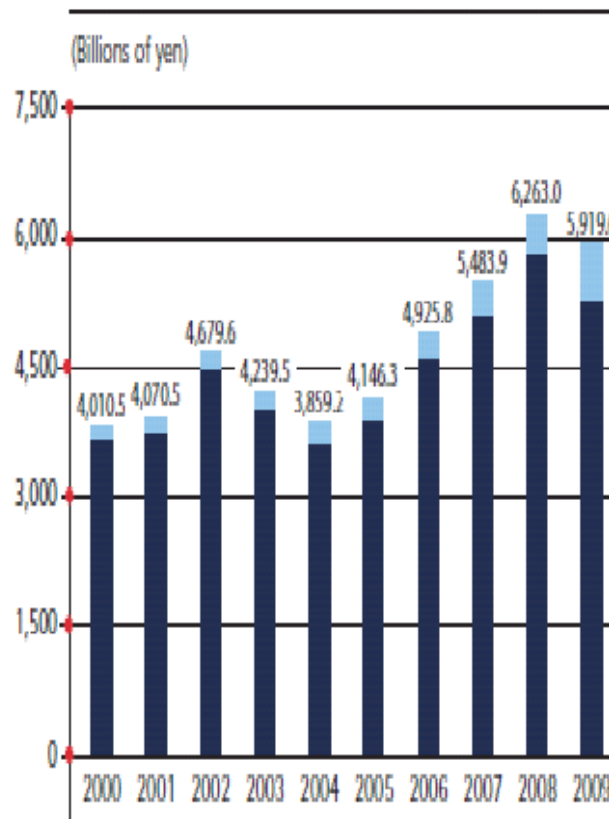

Shareholders' Equity

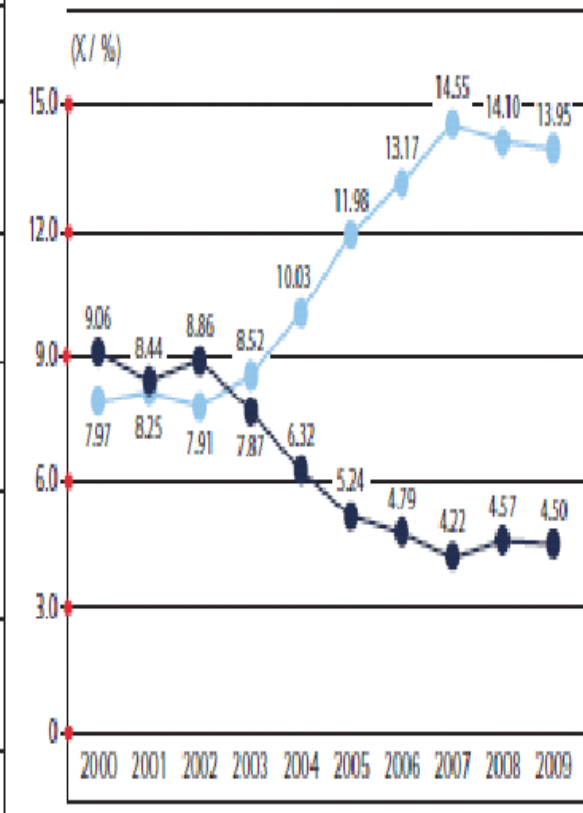


Interest-Bearing Debt (Long-term Debt and Deposits)

Long-term debt

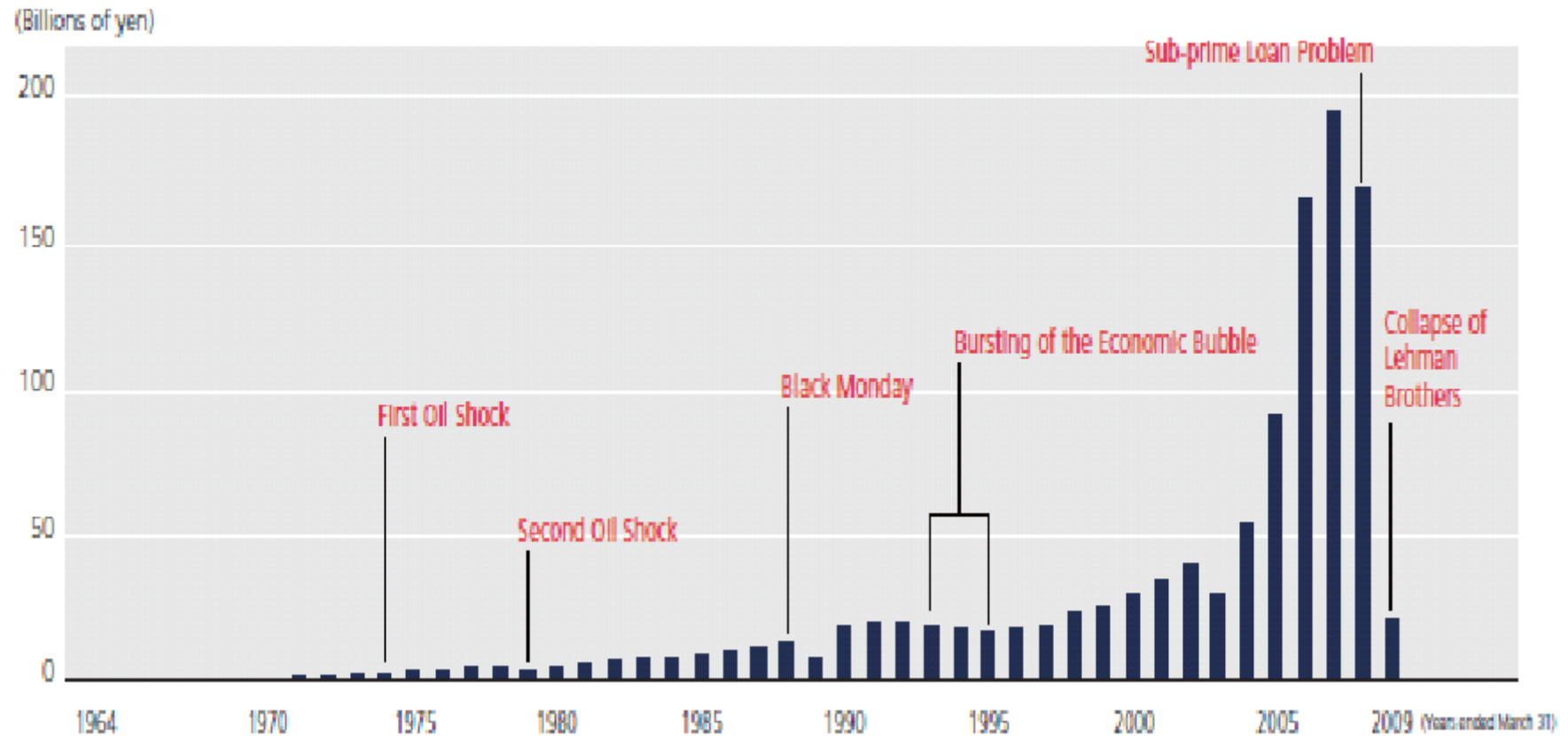
Debt-Equity Ratio / Shareholders' Equity Ratio



Debt-equity ratio Shareholders' equity ratio

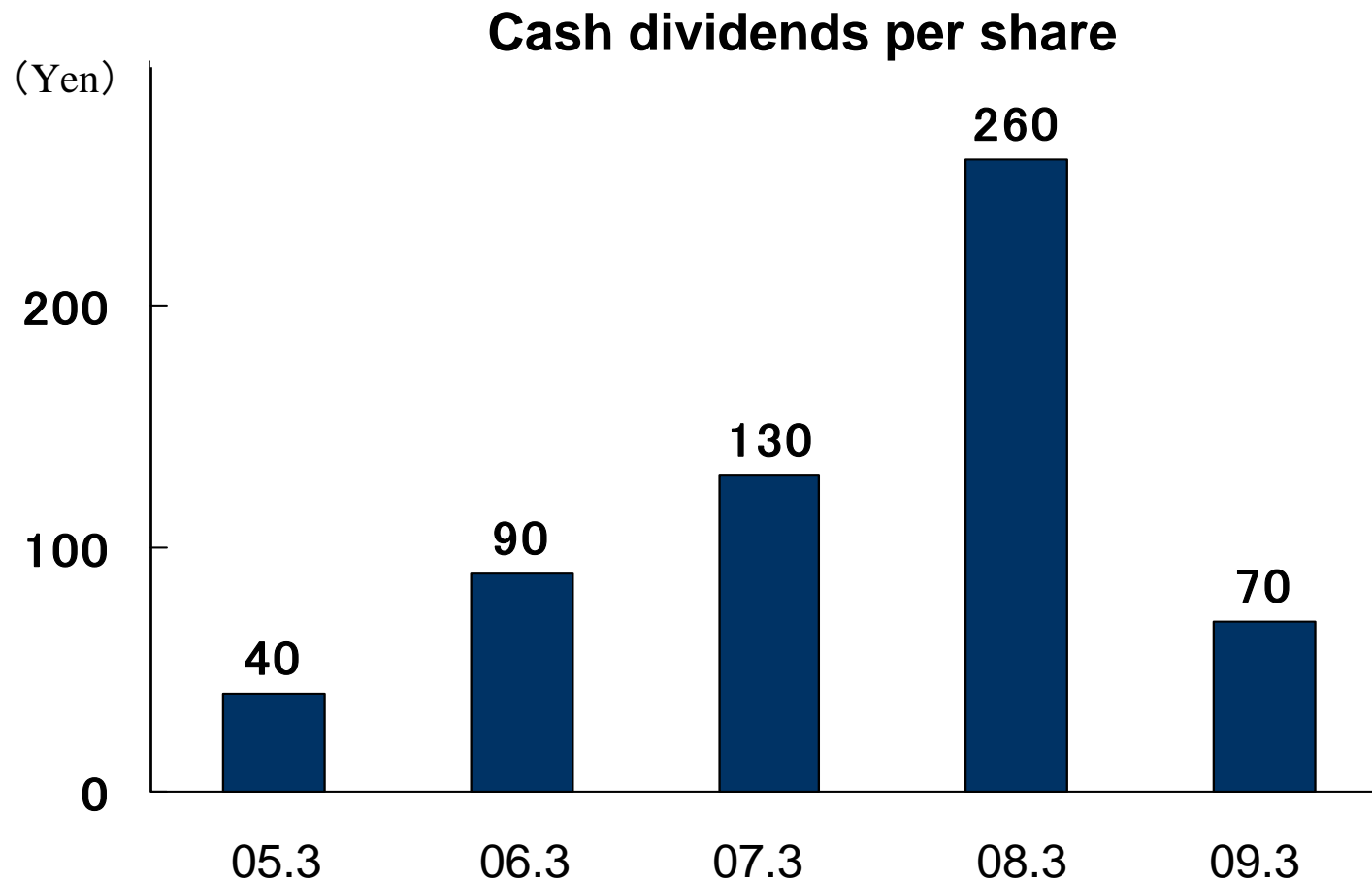
ORIX's Growth Trajectory (Net Income)
