## ORIX to Issue the 157<sup>th</sup>, 158<sup>th</sup>, and 159<sup>th</sup> Unsecured Senior Debt Securities with inter-bond pari passu clause

TOKYO, Japan – February 24, 2012 – ORIX Corporation (TSE: 8591; NYSE: IX), a leading integrated financial services group, today announced that the issuances of the 157<sup>th</sup> and 158<sup>th</sup> unsecured senior debt securities for retail investors and the 159<sup>th</sup> unsecured senior debt securities for institutional investors denominated in Japanese yen with inter-bond pari passu clause have been resolved in accordance with the approval by the Board of Directors on June 22, 2011 and by the Representative Executive Officer on October 4, 2011.
