

ORIX Eco Services Implements Initiative to Collect and Recycle Fluorocarbons from Air-Conditioning Facilities

TOKYO, Japan – February 29, 2024 – ORIX Eco Services Corporation ("ORIX Eco Services") announced today that it is implementing an initiative to collect and recycle fluorocarbons from air-conditioning facilities in cooperation with a network of companies nationwide in Japan.

ORIX Eco Services provides customers with one-stop services for the collection, reuse, recycling, and proper disposal of unwanted goods using a nationwide network of more than 1,000 companies, including companies involved in collection and transportation, intermediate disposal and reuse. Under this new service, when disposing of air-conditioning facilities during the renovation of office buildings and such, fluorocarbons being used as coolants will be collected as an entire unit of equipment, and the entire process—from the recycling of fluorocarbons to the disposal of equipment—will be conducted in an integrated manner. Fluorocarbons can be reused by removing impurities.

Fluorocarbons are used as coolants for air-conditioning facilities and play the role of efficiently transporting heat in the air. Compared to carbon dioxide, they have an extremely large greenhouse effect. The suppression of fluorocarbon emissions—including the use of fluorocarbon alternatives—is a pressing issue in combating global warming. Recycling fluorocarbons reduces the production of new fluorocarbons and the CO₂ emissions involved in their production, and at the same time, contributes to the reduction of environmental impact through cyclical use.

As the first phase of this initiative, fluorocarbons used as coolant for Nippon Life Hakata-Ekimae-Daini Building—owned by Nippon Life Insurance Company—was collected and recycled. The CO₂ emission reduction effect* was approximately 86%.

ORIX Eco Services will continue to provide customers with solutions for the reuse, recycling, and proper processing of waste, with the goal of promoting a recycling-oriented society with reduced environmental impact.
